Donations

Thank you so very much to the many, many folks who generously donated money, school supplies and backpacks to make this event possible.

With the monetary donations we were able to shop and purchase the last minute backpacks and supplies needed to reach our goal!!

Back to School Event

- **1,200 backpacks and supplies collected**
- **1,200 students registered**
- **898 registered students attended the event and received backpacks**
- **77 alternative string bags with supplies given out during the event to those students who could not register**
- **100 backpacks were given out after the event to students who were not aware of the event or were unable to register due to registration capacity**
- **200 backpacks with supplies are stored at PB Ritch Middle School to be given to needy students during this school year or saved for the 2016 Back to School Event**

Other Community Programs (con't)

2014/2015 Weekend Backpack Food Program

- 16 Elementary Schools and their sponsors provided 592 children with food for the weekend
- 2 Middle Schools and their sponsors provided 21 plus students with food for the weekend

2015 Summer Lunch Program coordinated through Must Ministries during the 9 week summer break: TOTAL LUNCHES = 29,831

- CAYA collected, packed & delivered 14,954 lunches
- Hope Church collected, packed & delivered 8,556 lunches
- Dallas UMC collected, packed & delivered 6,321 lunches
