Comments from Vitality Survey

1. More reports on the positive outcomes of initiatives from the collaborative and it's members

 - We do important work and they need to be aware of it.
 - It is great that a commissioner serves on the board – would love for our 's to be invited. They seem so focused on infrastructure and not our important human capital.
 - Love the support shown by the school district and board.
2. I would like to have a representative from the Children's Cabinet speak to our group...**this has been scheduled.**
3. Have more of a commitment to having committee meetings.
4. Organize presentations and/or panel discussions for topics of interest for families.
 - Have these in locations most likely to attract parents, etc.
4. Provide an agenda for each meeting in advance of the meeting would provide the opportunity to properly participate – **an agenda and the minutes of the previous meeting are sent out the week before each monthly meeting.**
5. Need some ice-breaker/team building to development relationships/increase additional member participation a couple of time a year.
