Students are selected from Dallas and Allgood Elementary schools. The students are identified by teachers as potential candidates for the program by the following criteria: 1) Participate in Free Lunch Program 2) Need for academic improvement, and 3) Commitment from parents to get their child to the program each day. The students continue each year through high school. Each year a new rising 1st grade Horizons class is created from a combination of students from Allgood and Dallas Elementary Schools. If a child changes schools, they are still invited back to Horizons if transportation can be provided. The length of our summer learning program is six-weeks of full day attendance.
